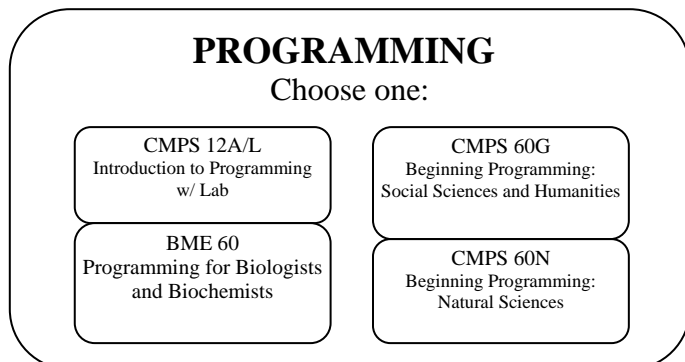
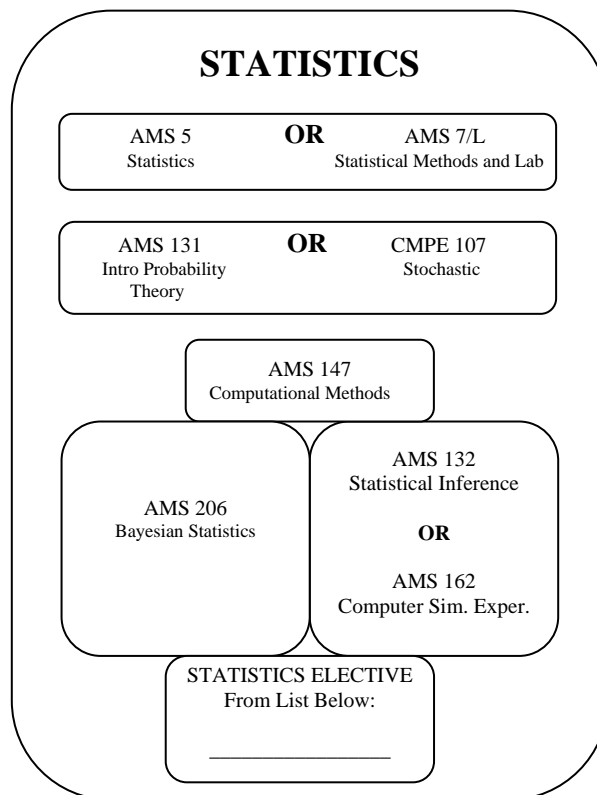
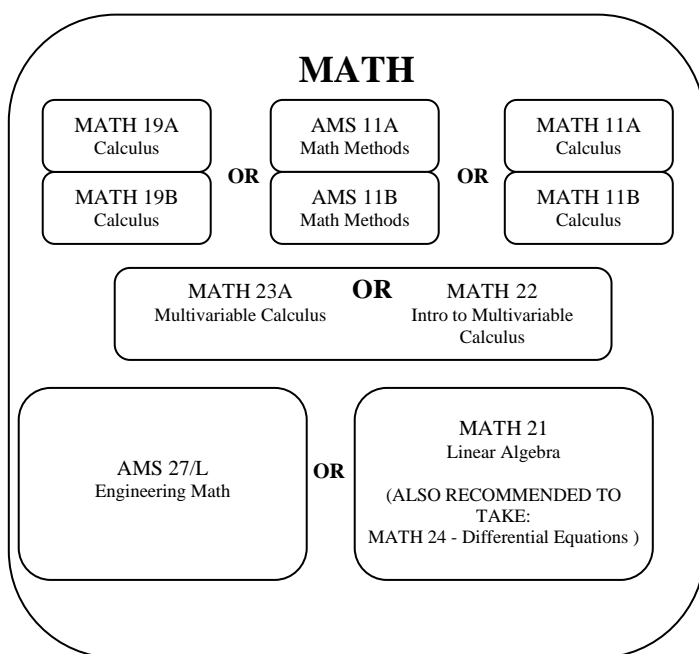

Information on the Statistics Minor

The statistics minor is available for students who wish to gain a quantitative understanding of how to (a) measure uncertainty and (b) make good decisions on the basis of incomplete or imperfect information, and to apply these skills to their interests in another field. This minor could also be combined with a major in mathematics as preparation for a graduate degree in statistics or bio statistics.

Course Information

At most two upper-division courses may be used to satisfy the requirements of another major or minor degree. With permission from the AMS department, students may substitute any graduate-level AMS course for an upper-division requirement. For students planning graduate work in statistics Math 21, Math 24, Math 23A, and AMS 205 are recommended, as well as Math 23B and 105A-B.
