
DESIGNATED EMPHASIS IN SCIENTIFIC COMPUTING

Upon electing to pursue a DE in Scientific Computing, students must choose a DE faculty advisor in the Applied Math (AM) department. This should be done at least one quarter before the student's Qualifying Examination (for PhD students) or their planned graduation date (for Master's students).

A list of eligible DE advisors is maintained online. The student should organize a preliminary meeting with the DE advisor, and agree on a plan for completion of the DE requirements. Once this plan has been designated, the student and the advisor must complete the following form. The completed form should then be signed by the student's home department advisor, by the DE advisor, and by the AM Graduate Director, and then filed in the BSOE Graduate Advising Office (Engineering 2, Suite 595 or bsoe-ga@rt.ucsc.edu)
